Director's Note



A war does not have to be between good and evil or right and wrong. It does not have to be foreign or domestic. It can be within yourself and in the choices you make. Now add a World War and a war within a family and you have Arthur Miller's ALL MY SONS. When I first read this play, and after directing DEATH OF A SALESMAN, my first thought was "Arthur Miller has daddy issues." But it was more than that. It became about the loyalty and devotion towards a father and how one moment of realization

can destroy that bond forever. ALL MY SONS added in the loss after war, the blame that soldiers who made it home put upon themselves as they wondered why they made it, but others didn't. It was how a family broken by war and loss also had to contend with their own inner demons, decisions, lies, and questions. Can our own homes or backyards become a prison without actually having the bars to keep you in? What lengths will we go to in order to protect our family? Will there be consequences for our actions and how, if at all, will we recover? This is the foundation of ALL MY SONS and only the beginning of where we started as director and actor. My goal for this production was to make the audience think about each character's actions, who is right, who is wrong, what would you do in their situation and what happens next. The best shows leave you wanting more and talking about them for days to come. And if any classic show can do just that, it's Arthur Miller's ALL MY SONS.

IAN FRASER ERNSBERGER has immersed himself in the world of theatre for nearly 30 years. Wherever he is needed to make the best production possible is where he will likely be. He has had the pleasure to direct past Classics series productions of TWELVE ANGRY MEN twice and DEATH OF A SALESMAN, while providing lighting and sound design for THE DIARY OF ANNE FRANK twice as well. As an actor, favorite roles include "Gomez" (THE ADDAMS FAMILY), "Seymour" (LITTLE SHOP OF HORRORS), "Felix" (THE ODD COUPLE), "Lord Farquaad" (SHREK), "Leroy" (THE BAD SEED), "Tony" (DIAL M FOR MURDER), "Eldridge" (SAVIN' UP FOR SATURDAY NIGHT), "Beadle" (SWEENEY TODD), and "Nick" (OVER THE RIVER AND THROUGH THE WOODS). 
