Welcome to HONK! JR, a musical retelling of Hans Christian Andersen's *The Ugly Duckling*. Our protagonist, Ugly, faces a harrowing journey of survival and self-discovery when he is born into a family that doesn't know how to accept him for being different. He is ostracized in the duckyard by the other poultry, including his own father and sibling ducklings.

As Ugly is thrust from his mother's nest and the safety of the duckyard, he finds himself out in the harsh realities of nature, struggling to find where he belongs. Ugly must make his way home before the harsh winter weather sets in. Ugly's journey brings encounters with a hungry cat, a squadron of geese, and a fancy-footed bullfrog along his way. Some are friends and some are foe... poor, young Ugly must find out for himself.

This classic Danish fairy tale has regaled children and their grown-ups alike for over 180 years. Its timeless themes of belonging, self-acceptance, and the beauty of transformation paint a relatable and heartfelt story for all ages. Ugly's story unpacks the struggles we all face as we search to find where we belong, learn to love ourselves for who we are, and discover that "...different isn't scary, different is no threat... Different is just... different!"



Lyvia played the role of Amanda


Thripp. Apart from musicals and plays with artsIQ, Lyvia enjoys
