

Director's Note



OLIVER! is based on Charles Dickens' second novel about an orphan who navigates the grinding bedrock of the English Industrial Revolution. It is classic Dickens in its unsparing portrait of Victorian society. Young Oliver Twist shuffles from workhouse to undertaker and eventually the stinking streets of London, where he falls in with the Artful Dodger and criminal father figure, Fagin. What I love about this story is that it's as simple as a little kid who believes

he wants more in the world and instigates change. The story is about how urban culture denies the needs of its children. It resonates today with the digital and technology revolutions that threaten to leave whole classes of people behind. What's the cost of advancement, and who does that serve? The miracle of Dickens is that even though he exposed the horrors that lived down those grimy alleys, he revealed the humanity in each of them. He showed us that these were human beings with fate and circumstances thrust upon them, and their actions were not that much different from the despicable behavior of some people in the upper classes. We hope that by the end of the production, our audience will be asking the most famous line spoken by Oliver, "Please, sir, may I have some more?" ACTORS PLACES, CURTAIN UP!

Bruce Jacklin, Director

BRUCE JACKLIN has directed and acted in more than 150 productions in the last 30 years. This includes professional, summer stock, collegian, and community theatre productions. Bruce is a certified adjudicator for the Ohio Community Theatre Association and American Association of Community Theatre. He has received awards in acting and directing at both regional and state festivals from OCTA, AACTfest, Columbus Theatre Roundtable, and OTA festivals for productions including DEATH OF A SALESMAN, OF MICE AND MEN, TRIP TO BOUNTIFUL, WALLY'S CAFE, HIDDEN IN THIS PICTURE, DONKEY BASEBALL, NIETZSCHE ATE HERE, THE BAD SEED, and others. Bruce is a member of AFTRA/SAG (American Federation of Television and Radio Artists, Screen Actors Guild) and has appeared in numerous national and local television films and commercials. Bruce was also in the film treatment of Roy Berkowitz's NIETZSCHE ATE HERE. The film premiered in the 2013 Montreal International Film Festival. He won Best Supporting Actor at the San Francisco Actor's Film Festival and in 2014, he receive the Red Cross Education Hero Award. PCG Talent in Columbus, Ohio and Docherty in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania represent him. Bruce is the artistic director for both MTVarts and The Alcove Theatre productions.


