

Director's Note

My first memory of encountering Dr. Seuss was reading "The Cat in the Hat" to my younger sister when I was just 8 years old. She was 3 and a half, and we only got through the first 4 pages before I called in back-up to help with all the unfamiliar words!

For generations now the colorful, crazy-named characters of Dr. Seuss have been a defining characteristic of growing up for children all over the world. His books, which have been translated into over 20 different languages and distributed in over 100 countries world-wide, bring imagination to the forefront of storytelling. With his signature rhymes and make-believe creatures filling page after page, it's no wonder these stories have stood the test of time.

But it wasn't until 2000, over a decade after his passing, that Dr. Seuss' stories came to the stage in a fantastical mash-up of no less than 4 of his most beloved stories. In this version made for young performers, you will experience Dr. Seuss in a whole new way. Set to a lively, whimsical melody of songs, Seussical JR takes us all on a journey through The Jungle of Nool, to Kalamazoo, to the tiniest planet of all—called Who! And through it all we watch as Horton, Gertrude McFuzz, Mayzie, and even the Sour Kangaroo learn a little something about themselves and what it means to treat those different from you with empathy and kindness.

Thanks to all the families who tirelessly bring their kids to rehearsal night after night, the kids who have been working so very hard, the volunteers that give of their time, and a big THANK YOU to each of you for coming to the show, and for all the support you give to artslQ. We could not offer the opportunities to young actors that we do without all of you!




