#### **Director's Note**



With SHREK THE MUSICAL JR., beauty is in the eye of the "OGRE." Based on the Oscar-winning DreamWorks Animation film and the fantastic Broadway musical, the world of SHREK JR. comes to artsIQ. It's a "big bright beautiful world" as everyone's favorite ogre leads a cast of fairytale misfits on an adventure to rescue a princess and find true acceptance. Thanks for coming and experiencing the outcome of hours of rehearsal, of personal commitment and the labor of love that make this show possible. Our reward is watching parents, friends, and family smile with immense pride as they experience the next generation take the stage in SHREK THE MUSICAL JR. ENJOY!




